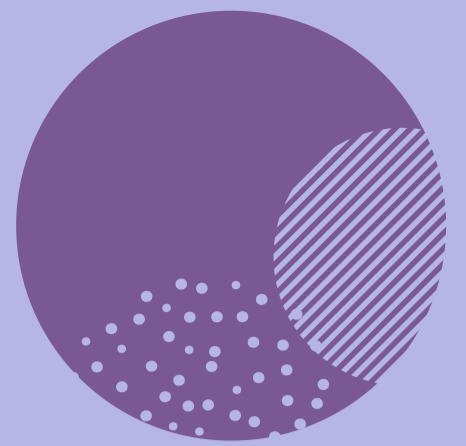

Average wage: £12-£20 per hour

Average wage: £18k-£45k per annum

Toxicologist, Environmental Health Officer, Paramedic
